**My dear friends,**



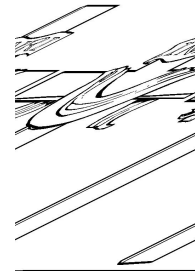
